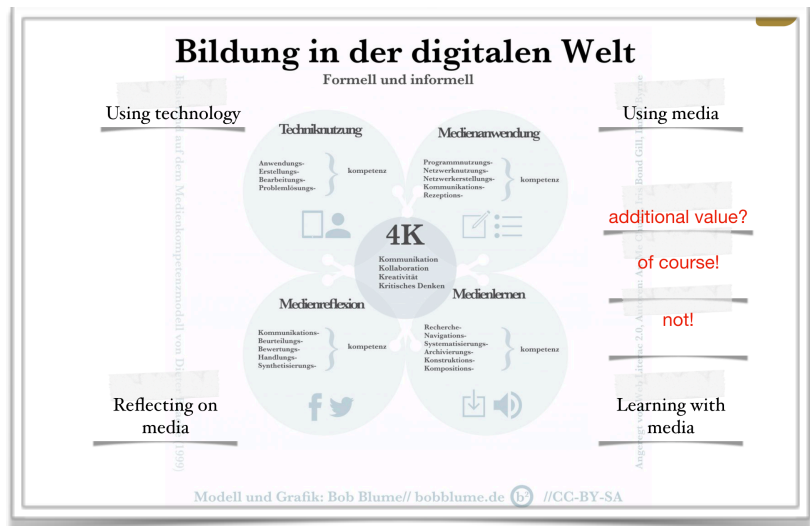

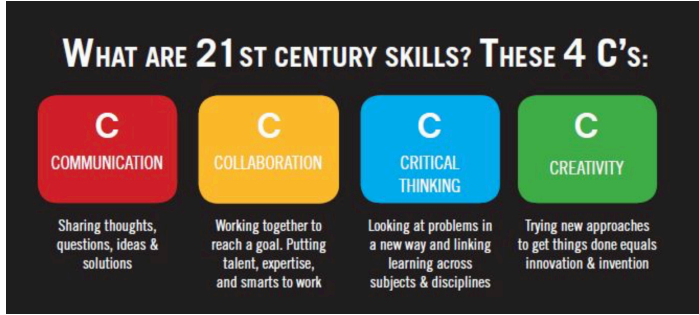

The 4c

Tablets or Computers?

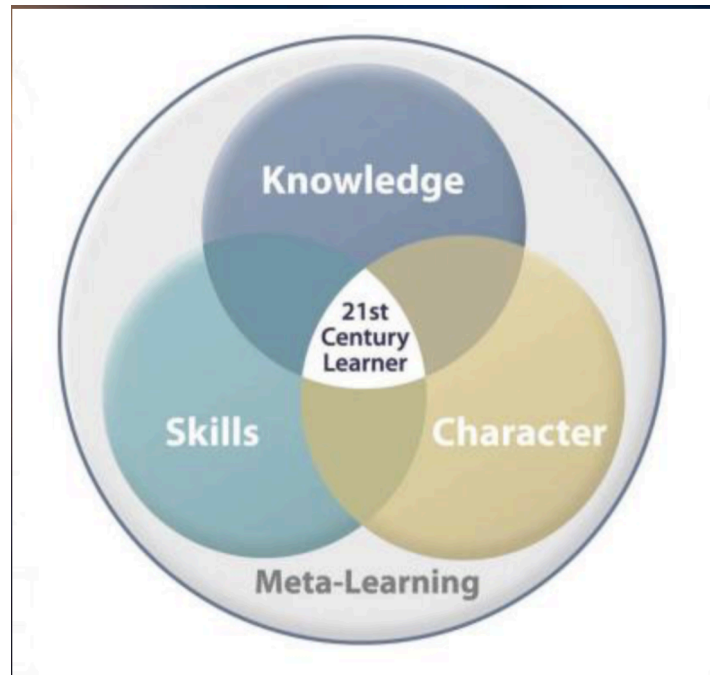
If you don't have a lot of equipment, this is an important question. It comes down to the most important question: What kind of learning you want your students to participate in?

Tablets or iPads (which are much more expensive but offer far more apps for education) don't have to be used in the same room. They can be carried around and can be integrated into very different learning environments.

Plan

Before you buy anything, you need to have a plan: What is already there? Methods? Know-how? Tech?

Take your time to make a plan before buying expensive tech that nobody knows how to use.



Meta-Learning

Besides knowledge and skills that go together with character (and the ability to make moral decisions), meta learning becomes increasingly important. That means: Which tools do the learners want to use in order to have the best results? Therefore, students (and teachers) have to know a broad variety of techniques, platforms and tools in order to decide which of these fits their *individual learning* best.
